

Procedure 201p1: Boundary Map of the Library District

- 1. **North Boundary:** Highway 20 is essentially the northernmost boundary of the La Conner Regional Library District.
- 2. **West Boundary:** The shoreline and nearby islands of Similk Bay and Skagit Bay are the western boundaries of the Library District.
- 3. **The East Boundary**: The Library District is formed by many right angles from Best Road to Jungquist/Beaver Marsh, to Calhoun/Bradshaw Road. South of the Skagit River, the district follows the Fir Island Road to the East 90° turn, then turns west.
- 4. **The South boundary**: West from Fir Island Road on Maupin Road to the Jensen Access road and water.

**Areas included in the district:** La Conner, Shelter Bay, the Swinomish Indian Lands, Channel area, Dodge Valley, LaConner Flats, Rexville, most of Pleasant Ridge, and the western part of Fir Island.

If a patron believes he is paying taxes to the La Conner school district and his property is not within the map boundaries, the <u>Assessor's Office Website</u> provides the best authority.

To find a School District for the address on the Assessor's web site: type in a house number and street name. Press search. Click on the parcel number and look through the record for the school district number. **SD311** is the **La Conner School District**. The patron would then be eligible for a library card at the La Conner Regional Library.
