WIRELESS INTERNET ACCESS POLICY

Free wireless Internet access is available at The La Conner Regional Library District. Just turn on your wireless enabled notebook/laptop computer or other wireless device and start surfing.

A. Requirements:

You will need a notebook/laptop computer or other wireless device with 802.11b or 802.11g wireless networking.

If you are not sure if your notebook/laptop computer or other device has this functionality, please check with the manufacturer or supplier of your equipment.

B. Limitations and Disclaimers:

We have tried to make wireless access as available as possible in our library, but you may encounter some "dead" spots where wireless reception may be limited. If you have trouble accessing the Internet or staying online please move to a different location within the library.

The wireless Internet access we offer is unfiltered. By choosing to use this free service, you agree to abide by the Library District's Internet Use Policy. This policy states the limitations of Internet access and your responsibilities for using that access.

The Library District's wireless network is not secure. Information sent to and from your notebook/laptop computer or other wireless device may be captured by anyone else with a wireless device and the appropriate software.

Library staff is not able to provide technical assistance and no guarantee can be made that you will be able to make a wireless connection.
